Travel Vaccinations

Most Travel vaccinations are available free of charge on the NHS. However, certain vaccines are not included under the NHS.

Rabies:

3 dose course: £60 per dose (£180 total)

Tick Born Encephalitis:

2 dose course: £60 per dose (£120 total)

Japanese Encephalitis:

2 dose course: £90 per dose (£180 total)

Cholera:

2 dose course: £30 per dose (£60 total)

Meningococcal ACWY:

1 dose course: £50

Hepatitis B:

3 Dose Course: £120

Anti Malarials

Generic Malarone

Taken: Daily for two days before you go, each day you are there, and for one week after leaving the risk area.

Cost: £65 for one week away (16 tablets)
+£35 for each additional week (+7 tablets)
£7 per tablet

Paediatric £35 for one week away (16 tablets)

+ £15 additional week (7 tablets)

£3 per tablet

Doxycycline

Taken: Daily (one tablet/day) for the week before you go, each day you are there, and four weeks after leaving the risk area

Cost: £25 for one week away (42 tablets) +£6 for each additional week (+7 tablets)

Private Script fee for anti malarials NOT supplied by us ± 10
